RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to prohibit the consideration of a regulation of individual activity disguised as a tax.

1 *Resolved*, That clause 5 of rule XXI of the Rules of
2 the House of Representatives is amended by adding at the
3 end the following:

4 “(d) It shall not be in order to consider a bill, joint
5 resolution, amendment, or conference report carrying an
6 increase in the amount of tax imposed on individuals
7 under chapter 1 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986
8 if such tax is determined by reference (directly or indi-
9 rectly) to the gross income of the taxpayer and the imposi-

1 tion of the tax is based solely on the taxpayer's violation
2 of a condition.”.
