Recognizing American Accomplishments

H.R. 3974 - Names the post office in Round Rock, TX after Marine Corps Corporal Steven Gill, who was killed in Iraq in 2005. Gill is a Purple Heart recipient, among several other awards.

H.R. 3721 - Names the U.S. Post Office in Lorena, Texas in honor of Marine Gunnery Sgt. John D. Fry, who was killed in Iraq.

- Status: Ordered to be Reported (Amended) by Voice Vote.

H.R. 3720 - Names the U.S. Post Office in Waco, Texas in honor of Army Pfc. Juan Alonso Covarrubias, who was killed in Vietnam.

- Status: Passed House

H.Res. 691 - Commending the Wings Over Houston Airshow for its great contribution to the appreciation, understanding, and future of the United States Armed Forces, the City of Houston, Texas, and Ellington Field.

- Status: Passed House

H.Res. 585 - Honoring the extraordinary life of legendary reporter, television personality, international humanitarian, and Houston icon Marvin Harold Zindler, who championed the cause of the economically powerless, politically underrepresented, and physically ill and disabled in Houston, across the nation, and around the world.

H.Res. 553 - Honors the life of the late widow of President Lyndon Baines Johnson, Claudia Alta Taylor Johnson, or "Lady Bird." Lady Bird strengthened the role of the First Lady in the White House, served her husband as a personal advisor, and was a great advocate for the environment. Mrs. Johnson spent the last years of her life on the Johnson ranch near Austin, Texas, and is survived by two daughters, seven grandchildren, and ten great-grandchildren.

H.R. 2750 - Requires the Secretary of the Treasury to mint coins in commemoration of the 50th anniversary of the establishment of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration and the Jet Propulsion Laboratory.

- Status: Passed House 402 - 0 (Roll no. 758)

H.R. 2688 - Designates the United States Postal Service located at 103 South Getty Street in Uvalde, Texas, as the "Dolph S. Briscoe, Jr. Post Office Building".

- Status: Public Law No: 110-73

H.Res. 490 - Honoring the 2007 NBA Champion San Antonio Spurs.

H.Res. 501 - Commending Craig Biggio of the Houston Astros for reaching 3,000 base hits as a Major League Baseball player and for his outstanding service to baseball and the Houston, Texas, region.

H.R. 584 - Designates the Federal building located at 400 Maryland Avenue Southwest in the District of Columbia as the 'Lyndon Baines Johnson Department of Education Building'.

H.R. 1978 - Designate the United States courthouse located at 101 East Pecan Street in Sherman, Texas, as the "Paul Brown United States Courthouse".

H.R. 1604 - Designates the headquarters building of the Embassy of the United States in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, as the "Mickey Leland United States Embassy Building".

H.R. 1425 - Designates the United States Postal Service located at 4551 East 52nd Street in Odessa, Texas, as the "Staff Sergeant Marvin "Rex" Young Post Office Building".

H.R. 1154 - To arrange for the presentation of a congressional gold medal to Michael Ellis DeBakey, M.D. who performed the first successful coronary bypass, pioneered the field of telemedicine, was elected the first President of Baylor College of Medicine, and received the Presidential Medal of Freedom with Distinction and the National Medal of Science in recognition of his many outstanding contributions to the nation.

H.R. 988 - Designates the United States Postal Service located at 5757 Tilton Avenue in Riverside, California, as the "Lieutenant Todd Jason Bryant Post Office".

H.R. 312, Civilian Service Recognition Act of 2007 - Requires executive agencies to furnish a U.S. flag to drape the casket of a civilian federal employee who dies in a combat zone, upon request of the deceased's next of kin or a close associate of the deceased.

- Status: Passed House

H.Res. 53 - Recognizing the life of Lamar Hunt and his outstanding contributions to the Kansas City Chiefs, the National Football League, and the United States.

H.Res. 69 - Recognizing and honoring Benny Parsons and expressing the condolences of the House of Representatives to his family on his death.
